Code of Conduct

Reference: Power to make code a by-law 78(g) and 48

As a member, visitor, social player or guest of the Club a certain standard of behaviour is expected that reflects the basic requirements of good sportsmanship, integrity, honesty, courtesy and respect to be shown to all other members, competitors, Club officials, staff and the public.

Without limiting the basic requirements of good sportsmanship, courtesy, honesty, integrity and respect, matters of conduct likely to reflect unfavourably are but not limited to include:

- Breach of the Club's Constitution and By Laws.
- Failure to adhere to the rules and etiquette of the game of golf.
- Use of threatening or abusive language or gestures to another person.
- Physical violence, threatening and or intimidating behaviour.
- Bad temper, damage or abuse of golf equipment and Club property.
- Actions that damage the character, goodwill, property or community view of the club.
- Bringing into disrepute by use of social media the game of golf, the Club, the Club's rules and regulations, Club officials, members and staff.
- Sexual harassment, racial vilification of any kind including conduct, comment, gesture or contact that is likely to cause offence or humiliation with respect to gender, religion, race or colour.
- Non-adherence to authorized Pro Shop instruction and course signage.
- Theft.
- Noncompliance of alcohol and smoking regulations.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct and unnecessary gamesmanship.
- Unacceptable conduct whilst representing the Dubbo Golf Club away from the club.

A person engaging in any behaviour inconsistent with the Code shall be in breach and such behaviour should be reported.
